INFORMATION & INSTRUCTIONS

This annual award was bequeathed by the late Ethel Raicus. Ethel Raicus instructed that this award should be administered by The Canadian Society of Painters in Water Colour, Canada's national watercolour society. Members of this society represent the best in Canadian watercolour painting, and one becomes a member by being elected to the society by members of the group. Many famous Canadian artists have been members of this society since its inception in 1925. The society holds a national exhibition each year. One of the mandates of the society is to promote the watercolour medium through education. Watercolours have been used in Canada for hundreds of years and have a strong historical significance in Canadian Art. This award helps to promote the continuance of this grand tradition. Only Central Technical art students are eligible for this annual competitive award. The 2009 award will be \$450.

The Canadian Society of Painters in Water Colour makes an annual award from the Ethel Raicus Fund. This award is named: **The Ethel Raicus Canadian Society of Painters in Water Colour Memorial Award**. The award is given annually to the best watercolour painting produced by a Central Technical School art student during each school year.

INSTRUCTIONS

1. You must be an art student at Central Technical school to be eligible for this award.
2. Students can check the **Canadian Society of Painters in Water Colour** web site to check the specifications for "watercolour" (FAQ's) at www.cspwc.com. In short, you would paint transparently using artists quality watercolours on watercolour paper. There is no size specification for this painting. *Acrylic paint does not qualify as watercolour paint in this competition.*
3. The winner agrees to accept this award at the school's graduation ceremonies or at an awards assembly, and also at an exhibition opening organized by the CSPWC at an appropriate point after the judging of the award.
5. The date for submissions will be set by the Art Department at Central Technical School.
6. The jury for this competition will be assigned by the Art Department at Central Technical School and may include a jurist from the Canadian Society of Painters in Water Colour.
